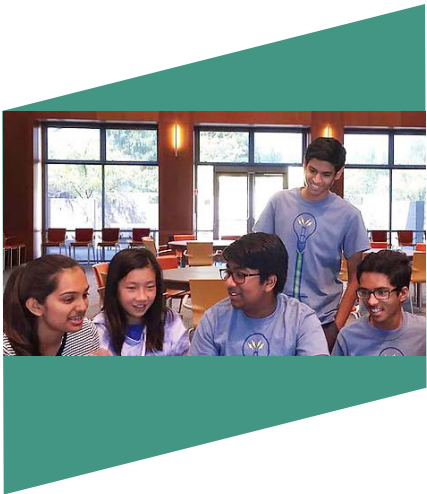
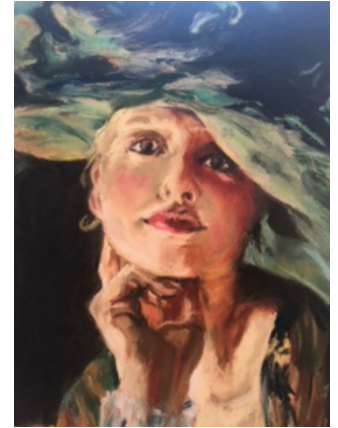
The mission of the Cupertino Library Foundation is to provide financial and creative support for diverse educational and cultural programs in collaboration with the Cupertino Library

SUSTAINABILITY

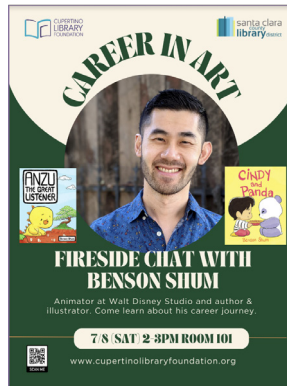

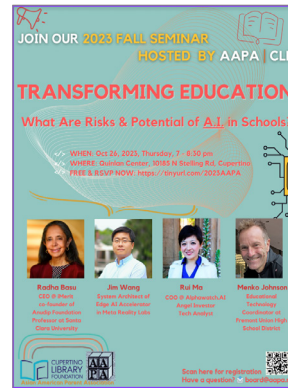

LIBRARY EXPANSION

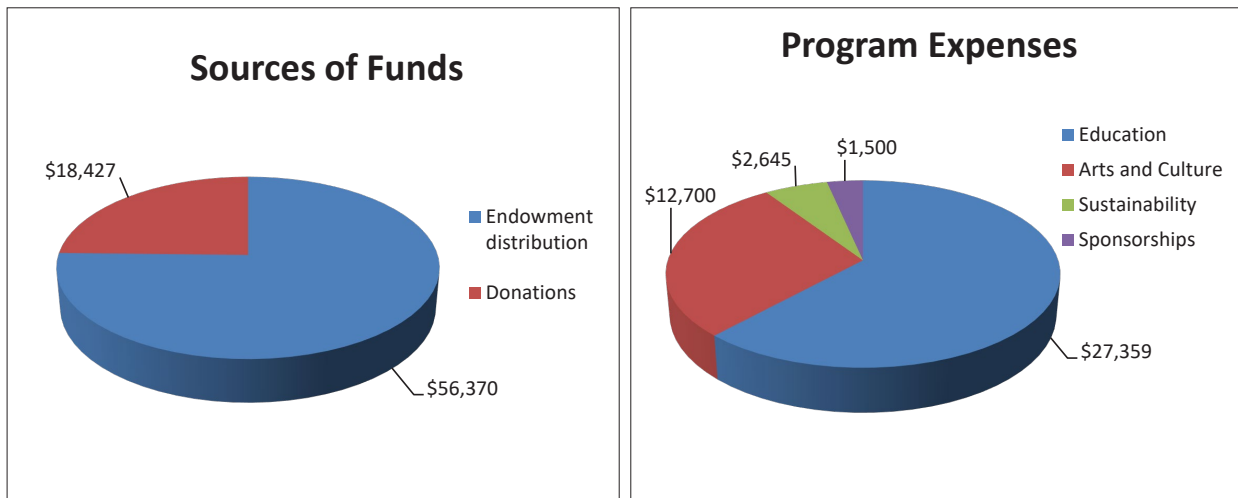
